Please note: hours of work and rest: 6 (1) Subject to the limit of an average of 48 hours of work a week over a reference period not exceeding 12 months, the limits on hours of work and rest in respect of a worker on board a sea-going fishing vessel shall be: (a) maximum hours of work which shall not exceed: (i) 14 hours in any 24 -hour period, and (ii) 7 hours in any seven -day period (b) minimum hours of rest which shall not be less than: (i) 10 hours in any 24 -hour period, and (ii) 77 hours in any seven-day period.
6 (2) Hours of rest may be divided into no more than two periods, one of which shall be at least six hours in length and the interval between consecutive such periods shall not exceed 14 hours.
